



HIGHLIGHTS

Though a short trip, it involves 3 serious days of angling for the Mahseer and Goonch on the lower section of Ramganga River. There will be short jeep drives, warm winter days or long summer days by the river, 10-60 mins walk on trails/ riverbeds, luxurious meals and stay at Camp Forktail Creek.

BEST TIME

Oct to May barring the coldest period i.e. from mid-Dec to mid-Jan.

OUTLINE ITINERARY

Day 0	Overnight in the train boarded at Delhi.
Day 1	Arrive at Ramnagar and transfer to Camp. Angling for the day. Night at Camp.
Day 2	Full day of angling. Night at Camp.
Day 3	Full day of angling and then depart for the railway station.

PLAN WOULD INCLUDE

- Accommodation at Camp Forktail Creek for 2 nights.
- Meals from breakfast on Day 1 to dinner on Day 3, aerated drinks, mineral or filtered drinking water and tea/ coffee
- Escorted hikes into the forests around Camp, if desired
- A dedicated jeep for three days for drop and pick up from the angling spot.
- Angling permits for 3 days (charges levied by the forest department are subject to change without prior notice)
- A dedicated angling guide
- A dedicated jeep for arrival transfer from Ramnagar Railway Station and on departure

EXTRA EXPENSES

Expenses of personal nature such as beverages (except those mentioned above) laundry, telephone calls, internet, souvenirs and tips. **The above cost does not include fishing equipment/ gear for professionals. We advise professionals to carry their own gear and would be happy to offer advice.**

FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION

Camp Forktail Creek is a small jungle camp located on the north-eastern periphery of Corbett Tiger Reserve, India (23 kms from the town of Ramnagar). It is set amidst dense Sal forests and accommodation is in locally handcrafted ensuite mud huts. Elaborate and sumptuous home-cooked meals accompany each trip with enjoyable, courteous and knowledgeable naturalists, who have been in the region most of their lives.

Camp is in a village which does not have electricity but ample lighting is provided with solar powered lamps and lanterns and candles.



DETAILED ITINERARY**Day 0: Overnight in the train**

Board the overnight, Ranikhet Express from Old Delhi Railway Station at 2245 hrs. Overnight in the IIIrd AC compartment of the train.

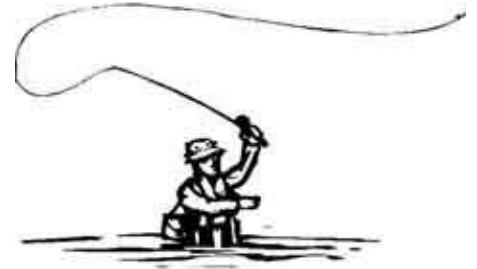
Day 1: Arrive at Camp.**Angling for the day.**

Arrive at Ramnagar Railway Station at 0500 hrs. Our jeep and driver would assist with transfer to Camp, a drive of 40 mins- 23kms.

After a wash and change, have breakfast and discuss plans for the days with your angling guide; then drive to the angling spot (12 kms away) and start fishing!

A packed lunch would be provided, specially prepared by the Chef in Camp. Back to Camp by sundown for tea, campfire and dinner, which is leisurely and personal. Along with the excellent cuisine, your guide and hosts will amuse and amaze you with their stories of exciting experiences.

Then it is time to relax once again and enjoy carefree chatter by the fireside whilst feasting on the unique sounds and smells that your exclusive location offers, before retiring to bed in a mud hut.

**Day 2: Full day of angling**

After an early breakfast, depart for a full day of angling.

Lunch would again go packed from Camp.

You would be back in Camp by sundown.

After a quick wash, join your hosts by the campfire for drinks and snacks and resume the discussions leftover from the previous night. For those of you weary from the long day, dinner would be ready under the Thatch after which you could settle into your comfortable bed in a mud hut.

Day 3: Full day of angling and then depart for the railway station.

Full day of angling (similar to Day 2, maybe a different fishing beat).

Return to Camp by sundown.

Wash and change, have an early dinner and depart for Ramnagar Railway Station for the overnight, Ranikhet Express at 2115 hrs for Delhi. Overnight in the IIIrd AC compartment of the train.

You would be in Old Delhi Railway Station by 0500 hrs the next day.
