



HIGHLIGHTS

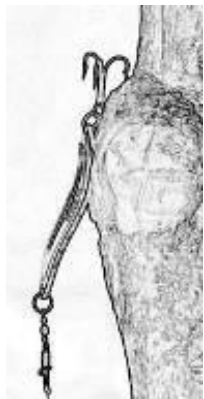
A specially designed angling trip on various sections of the Ramganga River for Mahseer and Goonch. There will be jeep drives, warm winter days or long summer days by the river, 10-60 mins walk on trails/ riverbeds, luxurious meals and stay at Camp Forktail Creek and in tents by the upper section of Ramganga River.



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BEST TIME

Oct to May barring the coldest period i.e. from mid-Dec to mid-Jan.



OUTLINE ITINERARY

- Day 1 Arrive at Camp by lunch. An afternoon hike into the forest around camp. Night at Camp.
- Day 2 Whole day angling in one of the beats on the lower Ramganga adjoining Corbett Tiger Reserve. Night at Camp.
- Day 3 Camp to the Upper Ramganga (4 hrs drive). Rest of the day spent angling. Night at the mobile camp.
- Day 4 Full day of angling in the upper Ramganga section and night in the mobile camp.
- Day 5 Morning session on the upper section. Post lunch depart for camp. Night in Camp.
- Day 6 Depart after breakfast to your onward destination.

PLAN WOULD INCLUDE

- Accommodation at Camp for three nights and camping by the upper Ramganga River for 2 nights.
- All meals from lunch on Day 1 to breakfast on Day 6, aerated drinks, mineral or filtered drinking water, tea/ coffee.
- Escorted hikes into the forests around Camp.
- A dedicated jeep with a driver and an angling guide on all days (except Day 1 & Day 6).
- A pilot jeep with supplies, chef and other assistants from Camp for the three days by the upper Ramganga River.
- All relevant entries fees and permits (charges levied by the forest department as subject to change without prior notice)

EXTRA EXPENSES

Expenses of personal nature such as beverages (except those mentioned above) laundry, telephone calls, internet, souvenirs and tips. **The above cost does not include fishing equipment/ gear for professionals. We advise professionals to carry their own gear and would be happy to offer advice.**

FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION

Camp Forktail Creek is a small jungle camp located on the north-eastern periphery of Corbett Tiger Reserve, India (23 kms from the town of Ramnagar). It is set amidst dense Sal forests and accommodation is in locally handcrafted ensuite mud huts. Elaborate and sumptuous home-cooked meals accompany each trip with enjoyable, courteous and knowledgeable naturalists, who have been in the region most of their lives.

Camp is in a village which does not have electricity but ample lighting is provided with solar powered lamps and lanterns and candles.



Camping by the upper Ramganga River would be in two-men tents which are fully functional complete with mattresses, pillows and duvet. The toilet tent would be a dry pit with a thunder box on top. Meals would be taken care of by the team from camp and would be a lavish mix of Indian or Continental cuisine. Our resident naturalist, cooks and camp staff would escort the whole trip and reach each place before us in pilot jeeps with all supplies. They would have each place ready for us by the time we get there.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive at Camp Forktail Creek

Arrive at Camp Forktail Creek by lunch.

After wash and change and a sumptuous lunch, we would take you on an escorted nature and bird walk into the Sal forests surrounding camp. It is an excellent opportunity to walk in the cool of the forest, to be so close to nature and to appreciate the varied plants, insects, birds, mammals and reptiles that inhabit this part of the country. THE QUIETER YOU ARE, THE MORE YOU WILL SEE.

Back to camp by sundown for campfire and dinner, which is leisurely and personal. Along with the excellent cuisine, your guide and hosts will amuse and amaze you with their stories of exciting experiences. Then it is time to relax once again and enjoy carefree chatter by the fireside whilst feasting on the unique sounds and smells that your exclusive location offers, before retiring to bed in your mud hut.



Day 2: Whole Day angling on the Ramganga River

Early morning depart from Camp by jeep for the Ramganga River (the best angling spots are about 12-16 kms from Camp) with your fishing guide and a packed meal. Whole day would be spent angling on the Ramganga River.

The Ramganga River is divided into four fishing beats. You would spend your day on either one of them, depending on what your guide advises.

Drive back to Camp by evening for campfire and dinner.

Overnight at Camp Forktail Creek

Day 3: Camp Forktail Creek to upper Ramganga River

Depart early morning by jeep for the upper Ramganga section, a drive of 4 hours from Camp. Arrive at the campsite by the river- packed breakfast on the way.

The whole day would be spent on various sections of the river with a picnic lunch.

Back to the campsite by evening for dinner and overnight stay in camping tents.

Day 4: Whole Day angling on the upper Ramganga River

Get on the river early morning with your fishing guide.

Whole day of angling on this section that promises some exciting fishing.

Back to the base camp by evening for dinner and overnight stay in camping tents.

Day 5: Upper Ramganga to Camp Forktail Creek

Half day angling on the upper Ramganga River. Pack up and drive back to Camp Forktail Creek by late noon. Arrive at Camp Forktail Creek by evening for campfire and dinner. Dinner and overnight at Camp.

Day 6: Depart for onward destination

Depart after breakfast for onward destination.
